At this point we are only able to vaccinate patients over 65, however from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> May we are able to vaccinate all remaining patients.

Just a reminder there needs to be a two-week gap between having a COVID-19 immunisation and influenza vaccine. If you are unsure, please do not hesitate to contact us.

### COVID Vaccinations

Your name, date of birth, contact phone number and your NHI number if known.

### **Prescription Ordering**

From Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June, our standard process of ordering a prescription is changing. Unless otherwise stated at the time of ordering, we will now be sending your prescription to your pharmacy of choice rather than needing to pick it up from us. Please ensure we have your pharmacy of choice on file when ordering, and if you would prefer to pick it up from the reception, we are still happy to hold it for collection.

New prescription fees will also apply from this date:

\* Non Urgent prescriptions: \$18-00

\* Urgent prescriptions: \$22-00
